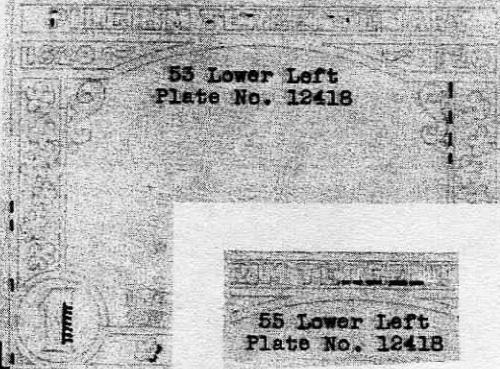

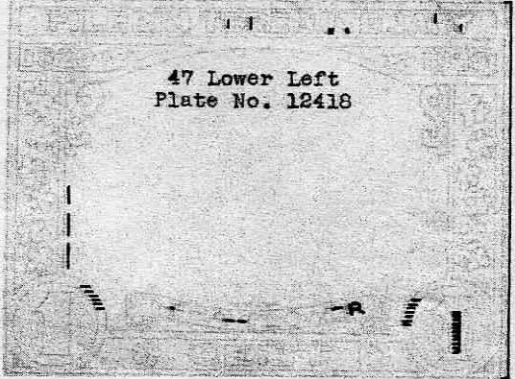
Dear Shift Hunter:

The diagram below gives us complete data on Plate #12418 except positions 36-37-43-44 & from 48 to 70 inclusive of the upper left pane.

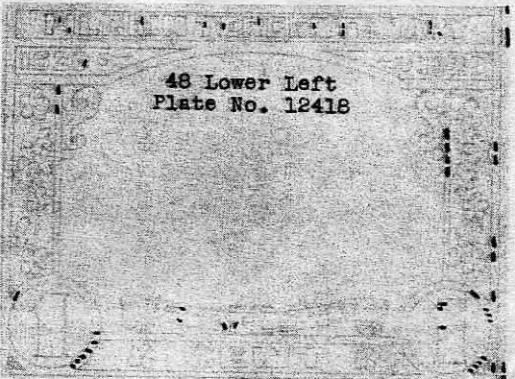
Is there a ribbed paper variety in the 2¢ 1908 to 1910 issue?



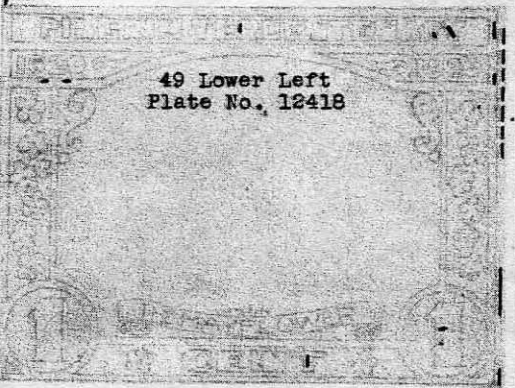
